## 1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

## 2. RULES

2.1 Racing will be governed by the rules defined in the 2021-2024 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), RYA Prescriptions, this Notice of Race, RVYC Sailing Instructions 2022, RVYC Race Chart 2022 and Class Rules, except where modified by the RVYC Sailing Instructions 2022 and special RVYC Sailing Instructions for Open Events. In a case of conflict, the RVYC Sailing Instructions 2022 or, for open events, the events special Sailing Instructions will apply.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Entry is open to dinghies, dayboats, cruisers and MOCRA classes.

3.2 All club racing series are open to members of the RVYC and non-members.

3.3 All competitors in club racing series and open events must lodge with the Club a completed RVYC 2022 Racing Entry form <https://www.rvyc.org.uk/page/racing>.

## 4. FEES

4.1 There is no entry fee for this event for RVYC members. A nominal £10 will be charged for visiting sailors.

## 5. BRIEFING

5.1 There will be no formal briefing for this event. Instructions will be posted on the blackboard located outside the Club's main entrance.

## 6. SCHEDULE OF RACE

6.1 The schedule of races and time of the first start is as follows :

6.2 There will be three races, the second and third race starting as soon as the previous race finishes

## 7. COURSES

7.1 Courses will be set using the RVYC 2022 Race Chart. Information on the courses can be found on the RVYC website, the RVYC racing noticeboard, and upon request from the RVYC office.

## 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 Sailing instructions will be available from the club website and be displayed on the official noticeboard outside the club changing rooms.

## 9. SCORING

9.1 The low points scoring will be in use. Information on discards will be in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10. PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be awarded for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> in each class. Extra prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority. Prizegiving will be as soon as all boats are ashore

11. **INSURANCE**

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with third-party liability insurance valid for racing with a minimum cover of £2,000,000.

12. **RISK STATEMENT**

Sailing by its nature is an unpredictable sport and there inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
