**ORGANISATION**

This event is part of the EWCC's Series. The Organising Authority will be SVYC.

**ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

Helms must be members of an affiliated RYA Club. The Entry Requirements on page 2 of this programme, which includes agreement to be bound by the "Risk Statement" in EWCC SI apply. There will be an entry fee which will be stated on the entry form.

**REGISTRATION & BRIEFING**

In addition to complying with the entry requirements, **entrants must enter the Regatta by filling out the online entry form at [svyc.org.uk/enter](http://svyc.org.uk/enter) before 23:59 on Sunday 6th August** (which will open one week before the event). Failure to do so will result in the boat not being recognised as racing. Where applicable, PY numbers must be included on the entry form.

**RULES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Races shall be governed by the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024. Races will be sailed under the East Wight Sailing Instructions, as varied by this Notice of Race. They can be downloaded from <http://www.ewcc.co.uk>. An addendum to the Sailing Instructions will be issued no later than 24 hours before the briefing, detailing the courses to be used, and any other additional information that has not already been published.

Protests must be notified to the Race Officer immediately after each race. Protest forms must be lodged with the SVYC Office within 45 minutes of the completion of racing. Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-turns Penalty is replaced by a One-turn Penalty.

EWCC SI 8.6 (passing through the starting line after starting) will not apply.

**CLASS SPLITS**

The event will comprise the following classes:

Junior Circuit: Optimists, Slow Handicap, Fast Handicap, ILCA Laser Handicap.

Open Circuit: Sea View One Design, ILCA Laser Handicap, Seaview Mermaid.

### **COURSES**

Racing will be from a Committee Boat. The Racing Area and Course will be published in the Sailing Instruction Addendum A and issued at the briefing.

**SAILS & EQUIPMENT CHECKS** - Spot checks to establish conformity with Class Rules may be made at the direction of the Race Committee before, during or after the Regatta. Boats in circuit 1 must not change boat/rig during the regatta. Boats in circuit 2 may change rig from day to day however.

**SAFETY** - When the race committee considers that a boat or a competitor is in difficulty, it may instruct the boat or competitor to accept outside help, retire and sail ashore.

**VHF RADIO** - Only competitors in keelboat classes shall be permitted to carry a VHF radio. From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions, and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

**SUPPORT BOATS** - are welcome but should not interfere with the racing unless required to rescue a boat in trouble.

**SCORING SYSTEM** - The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply. For Circuit 1, the series will be 8 races, with one discard if 5 races are sailed and 2 discards if 8 races are sailed. For Circuit 2, the series will be 6 races, with one discard if 5 races are sailed. For both circuits, a minimum of 4 races shall comprise a series.

**RESULTS** - will be posted on the Notice Board at the SVYC as soon as possible after the day's racing.

**PRIZES** - The timings for Prize Giving will be announced at the briefing.

**BOAT PARKING AND ACCESS** - boat parking is available in SVYC's Duver Dinghy Park, as well as a launching ramp. Further launching ramps are available on the SVYC Staging and the Halland slipway.
